Important events to be reported: Completion of the Fodder Factory from Isalnita

The management of Agroland Business System S.A. (the "Company") informs the market about the completion and inauguration of the Fodder Factory in Isalnita, Dolj county.

The Fodder Factory from Isalnita was built following an investment of RON 20 million. The annual production capacity of the new factory is 28,000 tons, covering approximately 60% of the fodder requirement for farms and stores in the Agroland network. The grains used in the factory will be obtained from the partner farmers of Agroland Agribusiness, a subsidiary company of Agroland Business System.

The production of the factory in Isalnita will consist of non-granulated, crushed and granulated fodder. The factory is one of the most modern and energy-efficient production units of this kind in Romania, all processes being automated, which allows the use of a reduced number of operators.

Following the inauguration of the factory in Isalnita, the total annual feed production capacity of the Company, which also includes the production from the Caransebes Combined Feed Factory, is 35,000 tons. This quantity represents approximately 75% of the total feed required in a year for the food and retail divisions of the Agroland group.
